

COMMERCIAL CLEANING PROCEDURES FOR CORIAN® QUARTZ

ITEMS TO BE REMOVED:

- 1. Red wine
- 2. Lemon juice
- Oil
- 4. Mustard
- 5. Blueberries
- 6. Coffee
- 7. Roasted vegetables
- 8. Beets
- 9. Hot Sauce
- 10. Vinegar

- 11. Hydrogen peroxide
- 12. Ammonia cleaners
- 13. Hair dye
- 14. Lipstick
- 15. Nail polish remover
- 16. Toothpaste
- 17. Shoe Polish
- 18. Isopropyl alcohol

ROUTINE CLEANING

- 1. Wipe up spills as they occur.
- Use a cloth or paper towel and a nonabrasive cleanser such as a general purpose surface cleaner. Dish soap and hot water may also be used.

ITEMS TO BE REMOVED:

- 1. Gum
- 2. Food
- 3. Food

- 4. Polish
- 5. Paint
- 6. Blood

DRIED SPILLS

- 1. Scrape away, using a plastic putty knife.
- Use a white, light-duty Scotch-Brite™ scrub pad and a nonabrasive cleanser such as a general purpose surface cleaner.
- 3. A Magic Eraser can be used to remove residual stains.

ITEMS TO BE REMOVED:

- 1. Tea
- 2. Grape Juice
- 3. Cigarette

LIGHT STAIN REMOVAL PROCEDURE 1

- Moisten paper towel or cloth with Greased Lightning[™]2, Saniten N323 Granite and Quartz Cleaner or another comparable product.
- 2. Rub stain remover into stain.
- 3. Let sit, covered by cloth for 15 minutes.
- 4. Wipe/scrub clean (may use non-scratch Scotch-Brite™ pad).
- Clean thoroughly with hot water and dish soap to remove any cleaning residue.

ITEMS TO BE REMOVED:

- 1. All stains that persist from lists above and
- 2. Adhesive residue from stickers or tape
- 3. Permanent Magic Marker®3
- 4. Ink Pen
- 5. Wite-Out^{®4}
- 6. Crayon
- 7. Iodine

LIGHT STAIN REMOVAL PROCEDURE 2

- Wearing gloves, moisten area, paper towel or cloth with a cleaner like acetone or nail polish remover (acetone or non-acetone based). Acetone and other solvents are suitable for short exposures only. They should be allowed to evaporate. Covering the solvent before it evaporates will prolong exposure and may cause damage.
- 2. Clean thoroughly with hot water and dish soap to remove any cleaning residue.

ITEMS TO BE REMOVED:

- 1. All stains that persist from lists above
- 2. Industrial chemicals (wood stains, etc.)

LIGHT STAIN REMOVAL PROCEDURE 3

- Wearing gloves, moisten area, paper towel or cloth with acetone or nail polish remover (acetone or non-acetone based). Acetone and other solvents are suitable for short exposures only. They should be allowed to evaporate. Covering the solvent before it evaporates will prolong exposure and may cause damage.
- Apply a small amount of abrasive cleanser like Comet[®] Powder Cleansers⁵.
- 3. Gently work abrasive and cleaner on stained area.
- 4. Rinse thoroughly to remove any cleaning residue.

ITEMS TO BE REMOVED:

1. Water spots (calcium deposits) and rust stains

WATER SPOT AND RUST REMOVAL

 Apply calcium/rust remover to a white cotton Scotch-Brite[™] or 0000 steel wool and rub affected area. An effective water mark/rust remover is CLR^{®6}.
