Solid Surface can be specified with the following finishes:

**Matte Finish** - The vast majority of lighter color countertops should be finished in a matte finish to provide easy maintenance. Matte finishes in darker colors may be prone to showing oils from hand contact.

**Semi-gloss Finish** - Semi-gloss finishes are recommended on dark colors for easier cleaning and a darker, richer appearance. If a matte finish is desired, follow the guidance for light colors.

**Gloss Finish** - A gloss finish in the appropriate end-use application is an aesthetically pleasing finish for Corian® Solid Surface. However, scratches are more visible with this type of finish and it requires more care and attention to maintain its appearance. It is not recommended to install a top with a high-gloss finish in a high-traffic or high-use area. If requested to do so, you should clearly advise the consumer of the special care needed to prevent unrealistic expectations.

These colors have been certified by SCS Global Services to have one of three minimum levels of pre-consumer recycled material: 6%, 10%, 14%.
